2 or 3 day trip all included



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SACRED RIVERS CAMP 2 OR 3 DAY TRIP ALL INCLUDED

(Season: all year round but February)

Come to fish with us some of the most amazing mountains streams and lakes in the heart of the Cusco mountains.

We will fish for rainbow trout and experience the Andean culture very close to Cusco and even closer to Machu Picchu.

This is a unique experience in the high lands of Peru you will be fishing with professional fishing guide that will show you some amazing spots in the mountains.



Itinerary:

Day 1: The trip starts in the sacred valley of Cusco, from there we will drive to the valley of lares, on the way to our camp we are going to fish a beautiful stream full of trout, we will have lunch at the rivers, fish a little bit more and at the afternoon we will go to our camp to take a hot shower have some delicious hot food and a good rest on our comfortable tents.

Day 2-3: breakfast is served at 7 am. But you will be able to get coffee or tea from 6 am. Right after breakfast we get ready to go fishing. We can either choose to fish a lake or the rivers that flows next to the camp. Lunch at the camp, after lunch we can fish a little bit more, then is time to pack and drive back to the sacred valley and cusco.

Included in program:

- Private transportation
 - All the meals starting with lunch day 1 until lunch day 2 or 3.
 - Fishing equipment
 - All the camping equipment
 - Professional and local fishing guides and assistance.
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Packing list:

We are going to be camping, fishing and hiking in the mountains and the weather can be cold, specially at night and early morning.

Wearing layers is the best option.

Down jacket, fleece, warm pants, rain jacket, extra socks, long underwear, hats or caps, sun glasses, sun block, gloves, beany, waterproof hiking shoes.

We are going to supply wader so no need to bring unless you prefer or you are more comfortable wearing yours.

Equipment:

Peru anglers will provide all necessary fishing and safety equipment, but if you prefer to use your own, we recommend:

#2-3 wt rods with floating lines for the small river. #5 wt rod for fishing the lakes. Floating and intermediate lines.

Tippetts from 2x to 6x

Most popular flies: wooly buggers, zonkers, and small streamers specially for the lakes.

Dry flies like stimulators, hoppers, royal couchman, etc.

Nymphs as prince, hare ear, copper john and similar work super good.
