The Madre de Dios River is born in the Andes Mountain Range, it is a plentiful river that opens its courses through the Amazon

rainforest. We will fish in the clear waters of the Madre de Dios River and some other smaller tributaries also of crystal clear waters.

ITINERARY:

DAY 1: This trip begins in the Sacred Valley of Cusco, with a road of approximately 5 hours by car to the town of Pilcopata.

We will be able to prepare the fishing equipment, inflate the rafts and have everything ready for the next day.

We will spend the night at a hotel in Pilcopata.

DAY 2: We will float the Madre de Dios River, fishing and enjoying the landscape, we will look for a beautiful beach to camp.

DAY 3: We will meet our friends and machiguenga guides to go back to the communal Lodge, we will fish on our way to the Lodge.

Lunch and fishing in the afternoon.

DAY 4: Breakfast at the Lodge and we go out to the river for fishing all day, in the afternoon we will return to the Lodge and have dinner.

DAY 5: Breakfast at the Lodge, return to the port where transportation awaits us to return to Cusco.





WHAT DOES THE PROGRAM INCLUDE?

- Transport
- Accommodation
- All meals (breakfast, lunch and dinner) from the first day to the last day's breakfast.
- Professional fishing guides.

SPECIES THAT WE FIND IN THE AREA:

- Sabalo (*Brycon amazonicus*) omnivorous fish eat from fruits that fall from the trees, insects and fish.
- Dorada (*Salminus hilarii*) a predatory fish, eats fish, insects, mice.
- Pacos (*Myleus pacu*) omnivorous fish eat from fruits that fall from the trees, insects and fish.
- Zungaros (Cat fish) bottom fish, without scales, feed on fish and carrion.

FISHING METHODS:

FLY AND SPINNING

FLY: The recommended equipment are rods # 6wt to 8 wt, with float lines and also sink tip lines.

For leaders, we use 8 feet of 30-pound flurocarbon tied with a 1-foot steel leader tip, to avoid cuts by the sharp teeth of the fish.

Flies from 6 to 8 cm. Especially streamers such as Andean deceivers, sonkers, puglisi streamers, imitations of small fish tied in hooks # 1/0, 2/0, 3/0.

Surface flies like mice, large insects like crickets also work just like fruit imitations.

SPINNING: Rods between 6 and 8 foot fast action for lures with a range wt between 15-50g.

Reels between 3000-4000 with 30 lb multifilament.

Steel tip leaders are necessary to connect the lures.

Lures such as crank baits, spinners #3-4-5, small rapalas, soft lures. Necessary to have strong hooks.



CLOTHES FOR THE RIVER

Fishing is usually going to be wading, it's hot so waders are not needed, but good wading boots are preferably with felt to have better grip on the stones.

Quick-drying clothes, all long sleeves for sun and insects protection, hat, sunglasses, buff, waterproof backpack to carry what is needed for the day, waterproof jacket, fishing gloves.



Fishing conditions may change throughout the season. Peru Anglers will advise as to the best options available at the time of confirming your reservation.
